Park Rules and Regulations

Updated as of 09/28/2013

Siesta Shores Parks (North and South) are for the enjoyment of all Siesta Shores residents and accompanied Guests.

- Only Resident and Guest may use the park(s).
- Guest(s) are the responsibility of the Resident and must be accompanied and supervised by the Resident while at the park(s).
- Please remove all litter when you finish visiting our park(s).
- Overnight Camping Is Prohibited.
- Use of Alcoholic beverages while at the park are not recommended and highly discouraged. (Also see Rules posted at North Park)
- Use and/or discharge of firearms, off road motor vehicles, open pit fires ARE PROHIBITED.
- Parking is permitted in designated areas only. And All motorized vehicles entering park must be licensed and registered.
- Pets are allowed but must be kept under control and cleaned up after.
- Disturbing, extremely loud music is not permitted. Residents within earshot of the parks and the music are authorized to tell you to turn your music down and/or have you leave the park(s).
- Special events must be pre-approved by Siesta Shores parks committee members or the elected Board members if the park committed is unavailable. However, keep in mind the parks at this time are not able to be reserved solely for the special events.
- Personal property damaged or lost or stolen at the park is your responsibility.
- Please use caution if swimming from the shore. There are no life guards on duty.
- Siesta Shore Park Committee or any of the Board Members can refuse access to the park for any unruly or unsafe activity.
- Please keep the gate locked at all time (after entry, after leaving, etc.). The gate is to not be left unlocked and open at any time.
- Leave plants and wildlife undisturbed.
- Beware and use caution when using the grills when the burn ban is in effect.
- Proper fishing license is required to fish from the shore.
- For large groups or parties, portable latrines must be ordered and on site throughout the duration of the party. And must be removed after the function is over.

These are just a few of the rules and regulations governing our parks. See also the Rules posted at the entrance to the North Park as well as those in the SS Restrictions and Covenants document(s).
